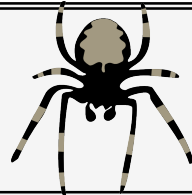


SESSION 1:

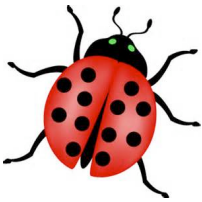
June 19 - June 30

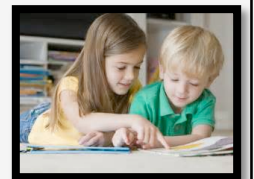


SESSION 4:
